HISTORY MODEL



Your task: Create a model of an important historical object in this unit using any materials (clay, cardboard, foam, Legos, candy, etc.). *You must provide your own materials.* Your model must also include a 2 paragraph report on the object.



This entire sheet must be submitted with your assignment, stapled to the upper left hand corner.

Your model must:

- Ⓢ Include a report (2 complete paragraphs) that describes what you have created and its historical importance.
- Ⓢ Be large enough that key details can be shown, but should not be larger than your desk top.
- Ⓢ Use proper proportions (you shouldn't have people bigger than buildings)
- Ⓢ Stand on its own.
- Ⓢ Be as accurate as possible, showing evidence of research for accuracy
- Ⓢ Include a list of materials used.
- Ⓢ Be appropriately colored (when possible).
