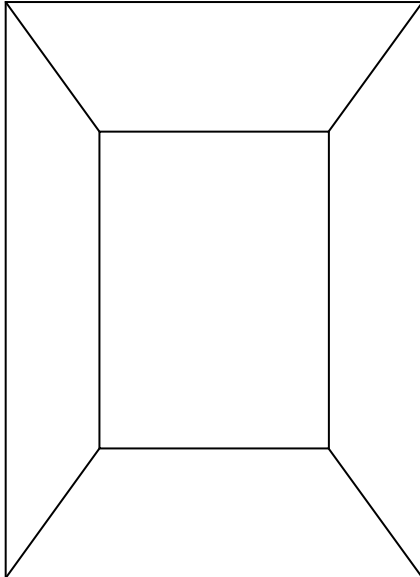

PICTURE FRAME

Instructions:

- Draw a picture frame like the one presented on your own paper. Your frame should use up the whole page.
 - In the center box draw a picture of your person, using color and quality with details.
 - In the top box write the person's name artistically. Bonus points if your art enhances the understanding of the person or their contributions.
 - In the bottom box write three sentences about what this person did, or why they are important. Use details from your notes/book.

- In the left box write a *personal* response to something the person did or said. (This reminds me of... It is fair/unfair that... I wish I knew more about...). Your response should be thoughtful.
 - In the right box write three questions that you would ask this person if you had a chance to interview him or her. Your questions should relate to something specific or important that the person did.
